

Q18. To what extent are you currently worried or not about each of the following issues for your life and those of your close ones? (%)
















The perception of how the situation will be in one year's time








Approval of the EU's support for Ukraine

Q13. Overall, do you approve or disapprove of the European Union's support for Ukraine following Russia's invasion of Ukraine? (%)










Q4. Would you personally like to see the European Parliament play a more important or less important role? (%)








Q7. Generally speaking, do you think that (OUR COUNTRY)'s membership of the EU is...? (%)











Importance of being an EU Member State











Satisfaction with democracy in the EU

SD18b. On the whole, are you very satisfied, fairly satisfied, not very satisfied, or not at all satisfied with the way democracy works in . . .? (%)









Satisfaction with democracy on a national level

SD18a. On the whole, are you very satisfied, fairly satisfied, not very satisfied, or not at all satisfied with the way democracy works in . . .? (%)














The importance of voting in European elections





Q21. The next European elections will be held in May 2024. How interested or not would you say you are in these elections? (%)








Q20. In your opinion, when will the next European Parliament elections be held here in (OUR COUNTRY)? (%)









Likelihood to vote in the next European elections






Personal voting behaviour




